Título: *Ayudando en la comunidad* (Helping in the community)

Tema: *Experiencias* (Experiences)

Throughout these chapters students talk in Spanish about volunteer work, recycling, and other ways to protect the environment. They also talk about what people say, what people did for others, and understand cultural perspectives on volunteer organizations. Cumulative activities are reading an article in Spanish about Habitat for Humanity and making a poster announcing a community-service project that invites students to participate in the project using the grammar and vocabulary studied. In Chapter 8A, students spent some time virtually visiting and discussing the natural offerings of National Park Sarapiquí, Costa Rica; National Park El Yunque, Puerto Rico; the River Delta Paraná, Argentina; Patagonia; Machu Picchu, Lake Titicaca, and the Nazca Lines from Perú and Bolivia in order to appreciate these protected places.
