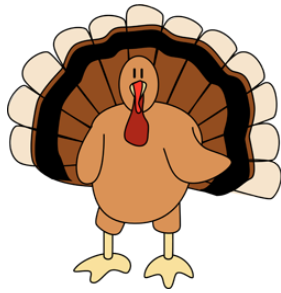


Grandparents' & Grandfriends' Day: Tuesday, November 26

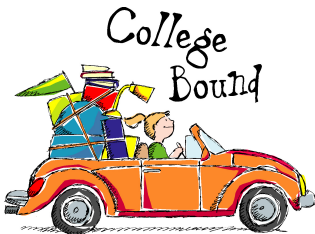

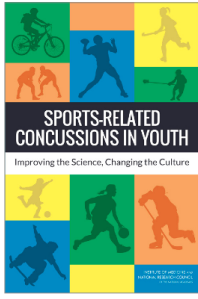
